

Pakwach district local government under the department of water handed over 5 projects to the community. The projects worth 171,458,989 shillings include drilling of deep boreholes at Nyarieg South and Ayangwa in Alwi Sub-County and Ayabu South in Ragem Sub-county, extension of piped water to Alwi Seed secondary school and Manakere village in Alwi sub-county and Construction of 2 stance VIP latrine at Payigoro auction market in Pakwach sub-county.

The Chairman LCV Hon. Omito Robert Steen tasked the community members to take charge of the water sources since it's their responsibility together with their local leaders. As a district, they have played their part but it's now the community to embrace the development.

The community members especially in Manakere village used to trek a long distance in search of water for daily use but this project has come in handy.

Pakwach District is mandated by the Ministry of water and Environment to carry on with the provision of safe and clean water and adequate sanitation to the rural community through the construction of water supply and sanitation facilities.
